The following hand crafted, world-class beers represent a selection of brands that are exemplary and unique throughout world.

LIGHTER STYLES

#1 NEW HOLLAND FULL CIRCLE LAGER \$4.50

New Holland Brewery, Holland, MI

A smooth and light bodied lager with a wonderful fresh hop character. Alc. 5% 12 oz bottle

#2 EINBECKER BRAUHERREN PILS \$4.50

Einbecker Brauhaus, Einbeck, Germany

A classic German pilsner, wonderfully malty and rich, with a clean hoppy finish from the use of the German Noble hop variety, Hallertau. Alc 5% 11.2 oz bottle

#3 REISSDORF KOLSCH \$7.25

Privatbrauerei Reissdorf, Cologne, Germany

The town of Cologne, Germany, mandates certain parameters for the brewing of this unique beer and protects the appellation worldwide. Kolsch is a top-fermented golden beer brewed with a long period of cold maturation. The result is a clean, crisp refreshing beer with a malty palate and a touch of fruit and vanilla. Less hoppy than a pils. Alc.5% 16.9 oz bottle.

WHEAT BEERS

#4 WITTERKERKE \$4.50

Bavik Brewery, Flanders, Belgium

A true Belgian Witbeer or White Ale. Brewed with wheat and spiced with Curacao orange peel and coriander, this is a light, refreshing and fruity ale. Belgian wit beers are cloudy as they are unfiltered. Alc. 5%. 11.2 oz bottle

#5 SCHNEIDER WEISSE \$7.25

Privatbrauerei Schneider, Kelheim, Germany

The “champagne” of wheat beers....Georg Schneider 1 was the first commercial brewer to brew this style of beer in 1872 and is considered the savior of this Bavarian style. Brewed with wheat and Vienna malt and fermented with Schneider’s classic yeast strain, this classic Bavarian wheat or Weisse beer is unfiltered, amber in color, smooth, fruity and spicy with hints of clove and banana. Try without the lemon first! Alc. 5.5 16.9 oz bottle

PALE, AMBER AND INDIA PALE ALES

#6 OLD SPECKLED HEN \$4.50

Moreland Brewery, Abington, UK

Named after a one-of-a-kind 1927 MG sports car, this is an English Pale Ale brewed with the finest of English malts and hops. Alc. 5.2 11.2 oz bottle.

#7 BELL’S AMBER ALE \$4.50

Kalamazoo Brewing Co, Kalamazoo, MI

Bell’s flagship beer brewed with pale, Munich and caramel malt to give a slightly sweet beer balanced with English and American hops. Deep copper in color. Alc. 6% 12oz bottle.

#8 EMPIRE INDIA PALE ALE \$12.75

Burton Bridge Brewery, Burton-on-Trent, UK

The first “IPA” was created in 1790 by George Hodgson, an English brewer who added more hops, brewers’ sugar and grain to an existing pale ale that was about to be sent to India to supply the Empire’s serving men. This was done to protect the beer against spoilage. Burton Bridge Brewery has recreated this famous style using the waters of the river Trent to create a pale, strong, heavily hopped and bitter ale that has also spent time aging in oak to simulate the time spent in transit! Alc. 7.5% . 16.9 oz bottle.

PORTERS AND STOUTS

#9 FLAG PORTER \$6.50

Darwin Brewery, Durham, England

Brewed in England from a traditional 19th century British recipe and fermented with 1825 yeast salvaged from a sunken vessel in the English Channel. Smooth, rich and chocolate-like, this classic English porter is truly delicious. Alc. 5%. 11.2 oz bottle.

#10 ARCADIA STARBOARD STOUT \$4.50

Arcadia Brewing Co, Battle Creek, MI

An oatmeal stout, deep black in color, robust chocolatey roasted malt character with a creamy mouthfeel. Alc. 5.4% 12 oz bottle

#11 BELL'S EXPEDITION STOUT \$7.00

Kalamazoo Brewing Co, Kalamazoo, MI

A strong and heavy stout with huge roasted malt character and very low carbonation. Alc. 11.5% 12oz bottle.

BELGIAN ALES

#12 LA CHOUFFE BELGIAN GOLDEN ALE \$10.25

Brasserie d'Achouffe, Achouffe, Belgium Bottle-conditioned, sweet, rich, and full-flavored, this golden ale is brewed with white candied sugar and spiced with coriander and has a hint of hops. Alc. 8%. 11.2 oz bottle

#13 MC CHOUFFE BELGIAN BROWN ALE \$10.25

Brasserie d'Achouffe, Achouffe, Belgium

Scottish inspiration is the source of this rich, wine-like spicy brown ale brewed with dark candied sugar. Alc. 8.5% 11.2oz bottle.

#14 TRIPEL KARMELIET \$7.25

Bosteel Brewery, Buggenhout, Belgium

This Belgian ale is unusual in that it uses a mixture of barley, wheat and oats for a fresh, intense flavor. Alc. 8% 11.2 oz bottle.

#15 LA FIN DU MONDE \$6.50

Unibroue Brewery, Quebec, Canada

A stronger golden ale in the "tripel" tradition, this bottle-conditioned ale is slightly tart with balanced flavors of wild spices, malt and hops. This beer is brewed to honor the great explorers who believed they reached "the end of the world" when they discovered America. 9% alcohol. 11.2 oz bottle.

#16 ST BERNADUS ABT 12 \$9.50

Watou, Belgium

A traditional Belgian abbey ale brewed in the classic style of Belgium's Trappist Monks. It is almost ebony in color, smooth, creamy and full bodied with big richness of texture. At 10% alcohol it is in the Rochefort 10 and Chimay Grand Reserve mold. Alc. 10% 11.2 oz bottle.

SPECIALTY BEERS

#17 LIEFMAN'S FRAMBOZEN RASPBERRY \$14.75

Brewery Liefman's, Oudenaarde, Belgium

Made from a base of Belgian brown ale, whole raspberries are pressed into juice and added to this beer to produce a massive raspberry aroma and flavor. Alc. 6% 12.7 oz bottle.

#18 FRAOCH HEATHER ALE \$6.25

Craigmill Brewery, Strathaven, Scotland

Brewed in Scotland since 2000BC, heather ale is probably the oldest style of ale still brewed in the world. It is brewed without the use of hops to replicate the styles of ale brewed before the commercial use of hops began in the 18th century. Sweet gale and flowering heather are used to spice this unique beer. It is light amber in color with a floral aroma, a full malt character, a spicy herbal finish and a dry wine-like finish. Alc. 7.5% 16.9oz bottle.

#19 KELPIE SEAWEED ALE \$9.00

Craigmill Brewery, Strathaven, Scotland

This recipe replicates the flavors of ales brewed along the coastal areas of Scotland where the farmers used seaweed beds to grow their cereal crops. Seaweed is included in the recipe and the result is a rich chocolate ale with an aroma of sea breeze. Alc. 4.4% 16.9oz bottle.

#20 EINBECKER DUNKEL-BOCK \$4.50

Einbecker Brauhaus, Einbeck, Germany

A bockbier is a German strong lager brewed with large amounts of malt. Einbecker dunkel-bock is medium-bodied, dark brown in color with an intense malt character and some hop character in the finish. Alc. 6.5% 11.2 oz bottle.

#21 AVENTINUS WEIZEN DOPPELBOCK \$8.25

Privatbrauerei Schneider, Kelheim, Germany

A double-fermented wheat beer brewed with darker malts to yield a stronger, rich and spicy wheat beer with hints of chocolate. This beer was named after Johann Aventinus, a historian who described Bavaria and its people. Alc. 8% 16.9oz bottle.
